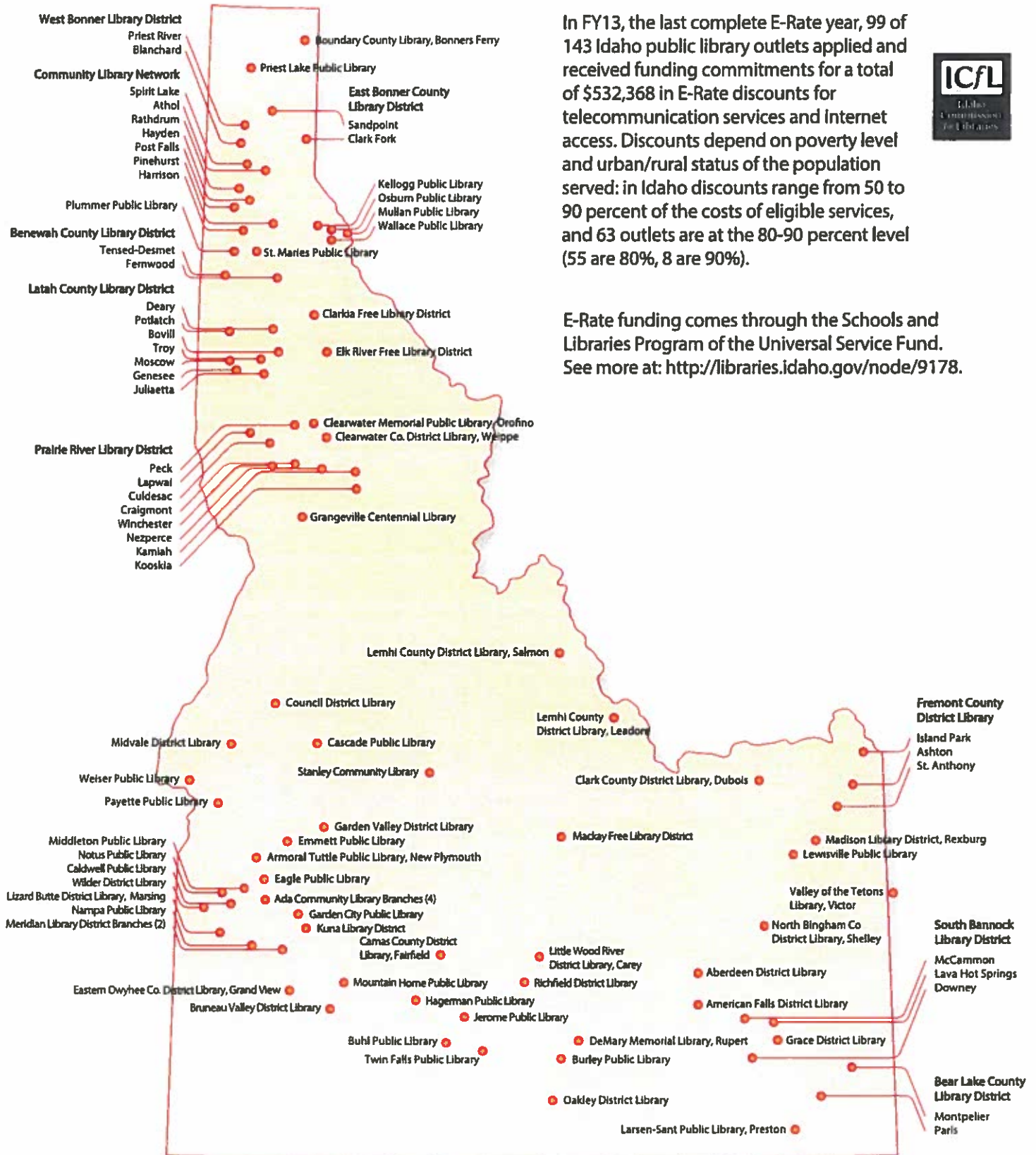


IDAHO PUBLIC LIBRARIES & E-RATE



In FY13, the last complete E-Rate year, 99 of 143 Idaho public library outlets applied and received funding commitments for a total of \$532,368 in E-Rate discounts for telecommunication services and internet access. Discounts depend on poverty level and urban/rural status of the population served: in Idaho discounts range from 50 to 90 percent of the costs of eligible services, and 63 outlets are at the 80-90 percent level (55 are 80%, 8 are 90%).
