

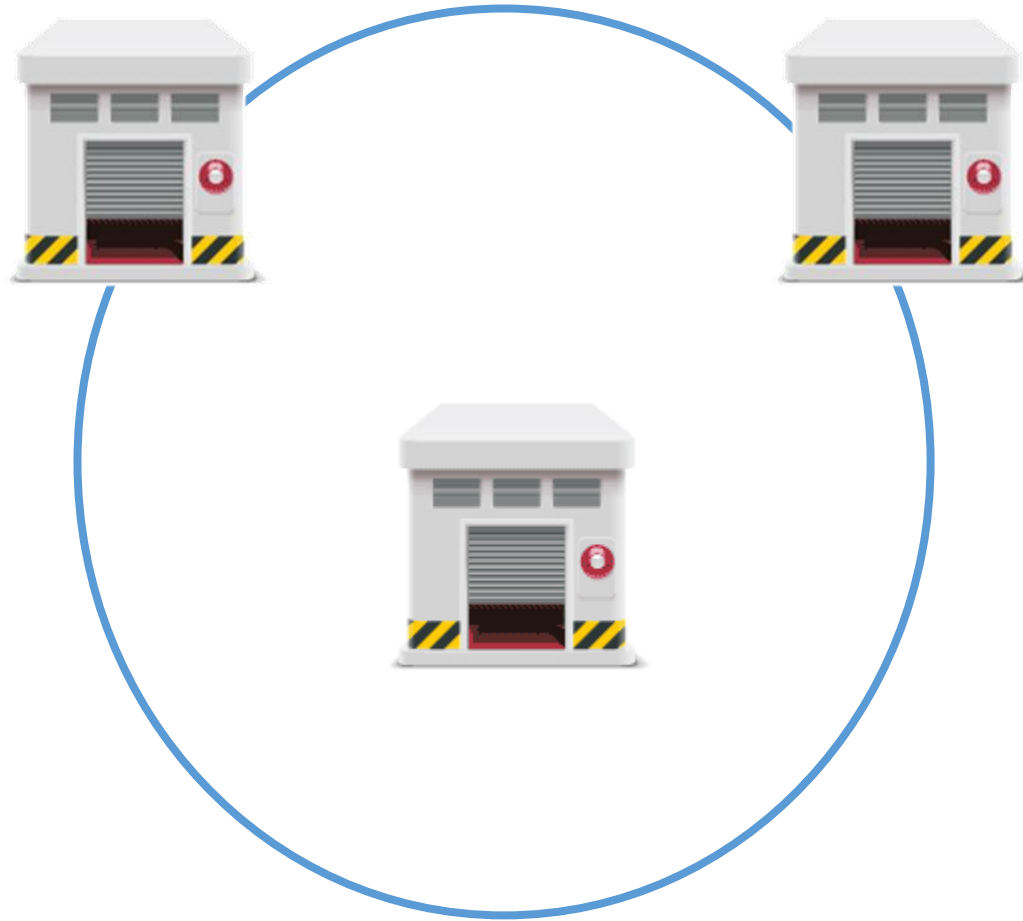

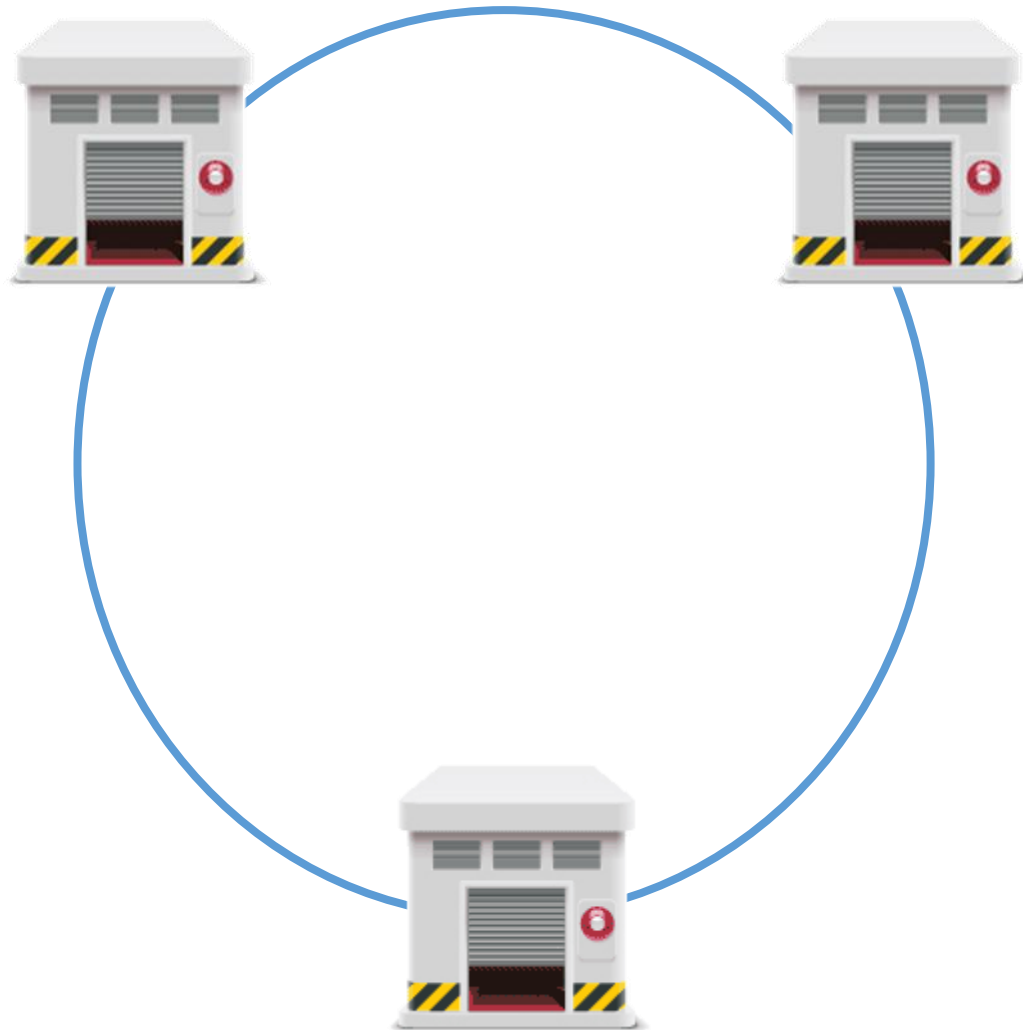
Where are we today?

- Residential pilot participants

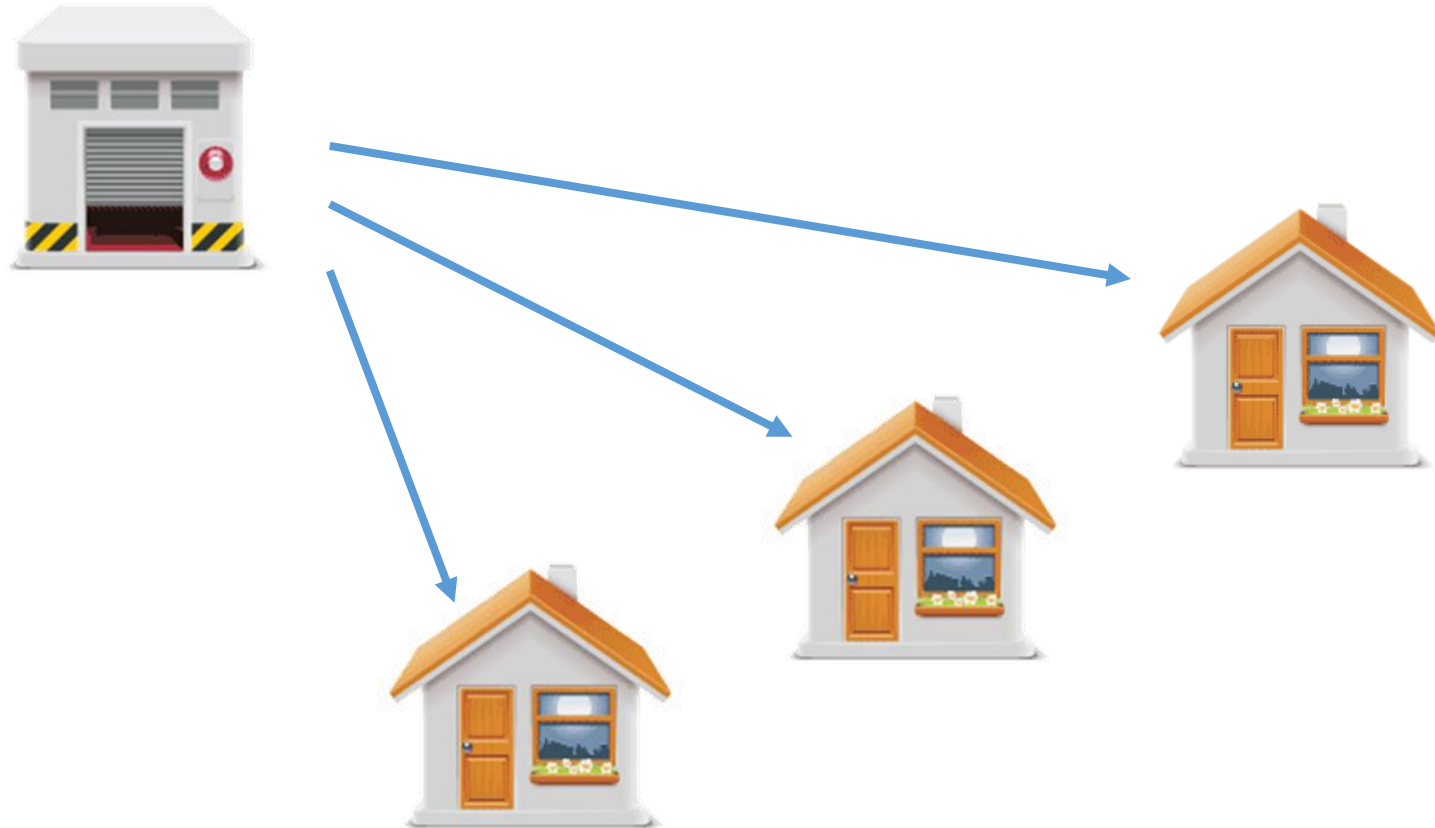

Open Access to the infrastructure

- Competition correctly applied to service
- Infrastructure correctly treated as monopoly
- End user ownership and control of infrastructure
- Unique combination of utility and financing
 - First in the United States to do it this way
 - Title II – Recognize it as a utility
 - Net Neutrality

Benefits

- Increase Public Safety
 - Department of Justice Award (\$75,000)
 - Lifeline Service (FCC)
- Market Research and Product Development
- Increase Free Market Competition
 - Existing provider/potential provider
 - Better for the customer
 - **More Choice**

How we use it:

- Adds value to residents and business owners property (\$5000)
- Superior Infrastructure (network media)
- Future Proof (next gen=port or equipment change out – not the fiber)
- Open Access to support choice and competition
- Utilizing Cutting Edge Technologies to provide:
 - Unprecedented levels of end user control and reporting
 - Edge to edge automation for instant ‘self service’ user experience
 - Improve Broadband service while reducing operational costs

What we need from the State:

- Protection for Municipal Fiber
 - Provide a protected pilot
- Middle Mile – State Participation (UEN)
 - Investment in Infrastructure
