
What We Do

Idaho Code §58-104(5)

The state board of land commissioners shall have power:

To determine the policy, direct the work to be undertaken, solicit bids, contract for work to be performed, and appropriate from its funds the money necessary to carry out such work. [emphasis added]




Our Process

- •We follow DOP thresholds for formal processes and many of their procedures creating a more consistent experience for vendors.
- •We often follow more formal processes than may be required to ensure competition and transparency in the procurement process.
- •We utilize State Contracts for commodities/IT purchases.
