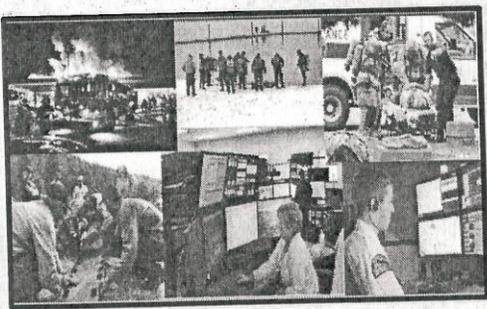

RELATING TO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS, AMENDING SECTION 31-4801, IDAHO CODE, TO INCLUDE INTEROPERABLE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS SYSTEMS AND DATA SYSTEMS AND MENTION THE CREATION OF THE IDAHO EMERGENCY COMMUNICATIONS COMMISSION AS ONE OF THE PURPOSES OF THIS ACT; AMENDING SECTION 31-4802, IDAHO CODE, TO INCLUDE NEW DEFINITIONS; AMENDING SECTION 31-4804, IDAHO CODE, TO ALLOW FUNDS TO BE USED FOR NEXT GENERATION CONSOLIDATED EMERGENCY SYSTEMS; AMENDING SECTION 31-4804A, IDAHO CODE, TO INCLUDE NEXT GENERATION CONSOLIDATED EMERGENCY SYSTEMS; AMENDING SECTION 31-4815, IDAHO CODE, TO CHANGE MEMBERSHIP IN THE COMMISSION; AMENDING SECTION 31-4816, IDAHO CODE, TO EXPAND COMMISSION RESPONSIBILITIES IN ORDER TO ACCOUNT FOR EXISTING AND FUTURE TECHNOLOGIES; AMENDING SECTION 31-4817, IDAHO CODE, TO INCLUDE INTEROPERABLE AND PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS AND DATA SYSTEMS IN COMMISSION MEDIATIONS; AMENDING SECTION 31-4819, IDAHO CODE, TO ALLOW GRANT FUNDS TO BE USED FOR ADMINISTRATION OF GRANTS; AMENDING CHAPTER 48, TITLE 31, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 31-4820, IDAHO CODE TO ESTABLISH AND ADMINISTER THE INTEROPERABLE PUBLIC SAFETY COMMUNICATIONS AND DATA SYSTEMS FUND; AMENDING CHAPTER 48, TITLE 31, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 31-4821, IDAHO CODE TO ALLOW FOR ADMINISTRATIVE SUPPORT AND THE CREATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE POSITIONS; AND REPEALING CHAPTER 12, TITLE 46, IDAHO CODE.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 31-4801, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

31-4801. **PURPOSE.** The legislature recognizes that providing consolidated emergency communications systems and interoperable public safety systems is vital in enhancing the public health, safety, and welfare of the residents of people in the state of Idaho. The legislature further finds that there is an obvious need for providing a means to finance the

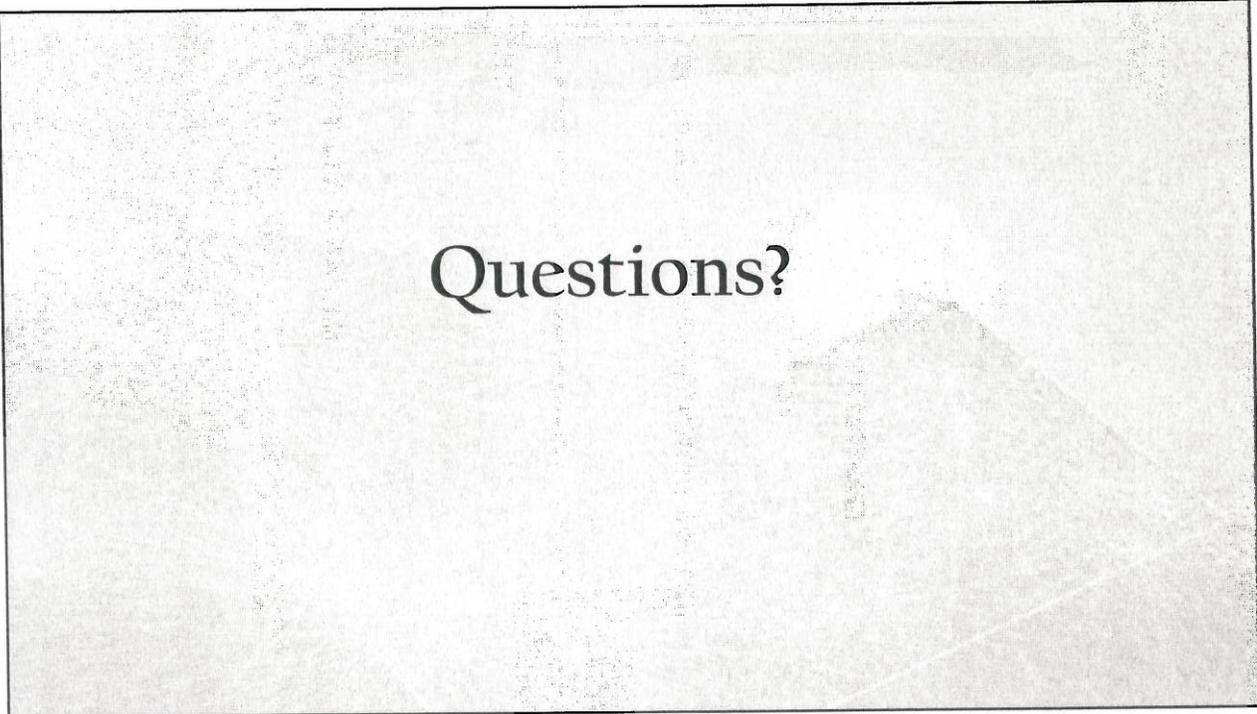
“One member representing Idaho’s Tribes will be appointed to serve as a non-voting ex officio member”.
