2 RELATING TO QUALIFICATIONS FOR ELECTION OF STATE REPRESENTATIVES AND SENA-
3 TORS; AMENDING SECTION 34-614, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE QUALIFICATIONS FOR
4 A PERSON TO BE ELIGIBLE TO BE ELECTED AS A STATE REPRESENTATIVE OR SENA-
5 TOR.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 34-614, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
8 amended to read as follows:

9 34-614. ELECTION OF STATE REPRESENTATIVES AND SENATORS -- QUALIFICA-
10 TIONS. (1) At the general election, 1972, and every alternate year there-
11 after, there shall be elected in each legislative district such representa-
12 tives and senators as they may be severally entitled.

13 (2) No person shall be elected to the office of representative or sen-
14 ator unless he shall have attained the age of twenty-one (21) years at the
15 time of the general election, is a citizen of the United States and shall have
16 ~~resided~~ been a registered elector within the legislative district one (1)
17 year next preceding the general election at which he offers his candidacy.

18 (3) Each candidate shall file his declaration of candidacy with the
19 secretary of state.

20 (4) Each candidate who files a declaration of candidacy shall at the
21 same time pay a filing fee of thirty dollars (\$30.00) which shall be de-
22 posited in the general fund.
