AN ACT

1 RELATING TO TRANSPORTATION; AMENDING SECTION 49-402, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE  
2 REGISTRATION FEES; AMENDING SECTION 49-434, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR  
3 ADDITIONAL REGISTRATION FEES; AND AMENDING CHAPTER 4, TITLE 49, IDAHO  
4 CODE, BY THE ADDITION OF A NEW SECTION 49-457, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE A  
5 FEE FOR ELECTRIC AND HYBRID VEHICLES AND TO PROVIDE FOR THE DEPOSIT OF  
6 FEES.  
7

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Section 49-402, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
10 amended to read as follows:

11 49-402. ANNUAL REGISTRATION. (1) The annual fee for operating each  
12 pickup truck, each neighborhood electric vehicle and each other motor ve-  
13 hicle having a maximum gross weight not in excess of eight thousand (8,000)  
14 pounds and that complies with the federal motor vehicle safety standards as  
15 defined in section 49-107, Idaho Code, shall be:

Vehicles one (1) and two (2) years old .....	\$4863.00
Vehicles three (3) and four (4) years old .....	\$3651.00
Vehicles five (5) and six (6) years old .....	\$3651.00
Vehicles seven (7) and eight (8) years old .....	\$2439.00
Vehicles over eight (8) years old .....	\$2439.00

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21 There shall be twelve (12) registration periods, starting in January  
22 for holders of validation registration stickers numbered 1, and proceed-  
23 ing consecutively through December for holders of validation registration  
24 stickers numbered 12, each of which shall start on the first day of a calendar  
25 month and end on the last day of the twelfth month from the first day of the  
26 beginning month. Registration periods shall expire midnight on the last day  
27 of the registration period in the year designated by the validation regis-  
28 tration sticker. The numeral digit on the validation registration stickers  
29 shall, as does the registration card, fix the registration period under the  
30 staggered registration system for the purpose of reregistration and notice  
31 of expiration.

32 A vehicle that has once been registered for any of the above designated  
33 periods shall, upon reregistration, be registered for the period bearing the  
34 same number, and the registration card shall show and be the exclusive proof  
35 of the expiration date of registration and licensing. Vehicles may be ini-  
36 tially registered for less than a twelve (12) month period, or for more than a  
37 twelve (12) month period, and the fee prorated on a monthly basis if the frac-  
38 tional registration tends to fulfill the purpose of the monthly series reg-  
39 istration system.

40 (2) For all school buses operated either by a nonprofit, nonpublic  
41 school or operated pursuant to a service contract with a school district for  
42 transporting children to or from school or in connection with school ap-

1 proved activities, the annual fee shall be twenty-four dollars (\$24.00) and  
2 shall be subject to staggered registration for the purpose of reregistration  
3 and notice of expiration.

4 (3) For all motorcycles and motor-driven cycles which comply with the  
5 federal motor vehicle safety standards, operated upon the public highways,  
6 the annual fee shall be ~~nine~~ fifteen dollars (~~\$9~~15.00) and shall be subject  
7 to staggered registration for the purpose of reregistration and notice of  
8 expiration.

9 (4) For operation of an all-terrain vehicle, utility type vehicle or  
10 motorbike, excluding a motorbike with an engine displacement of fifty (50)  
11 cubic centimeters or less, on city, county or highway district roads or  
12 highways open to such use, a restricted vehicle license plate fee pursuant  
13 to section 49-450, Idaho Code, shall be paid. In addition, the registration  
14 fee specified in section 67-7122, Idaho Code, shall be paid as provided in  
15 section 67-7122, Idaho Code. The registration and restricted vehicle li-  
16 cense plate exemption provided in section 49-426(2), Idaho Code, applies  
17 to all-terrain vehicles, utility type vehicles, motorbikes and motorcycles  
18 used for the purposes described in subsection (2) of section 49-426, Idaho  
19 Code. Nonresidents shall be allowed to purchase a restricted vehicle li-  
20 cense plate and sticker for an all-terrain vehicle, utility type vehicle or  
21 motorbike.

22 (5) For all motor homes the fee shall be as specified in subsection (1)  
23 of this section and shall be in addition to the fees provided for in section  
24 49-445, Idaho Code.

25 (6) Registration fees shall not be subject to refund.

26 (7) A financial institution or repossession service contracted to  
27 a financial institution repossessing vehicles under the terms of a secu-  
28 rity agreement shall move the vehicle from the place of repossession to the  
29 financial institution's place of business on a repossession plate. The  
30 repossession plate shall also be used for demonstrating the vehicle to a  
31 prospective purchaser for a period not to exceed ninety-six (96) hours. The  
32 registration fees for repossession plates shall be as required in subsection  
33 (1) of this section for a vehicle one (1) and two (2) years old. All other  
34 fees required under chapter 4, title 49, Idaho Code, shall be in addition to  
35 the registration fee. The repossession plate shall be subject to staggered  
36 registration for the purpose of reregistration and notice of expiration.

37 (8) A wrecker or towing business engaged in the process of towing motor-  
38 ized vehicles, which have been wrecked, abandoned, salvaged or may be dis-  
39 abled, may apply for a wrecker plate to be displayed on those vehicles being  
40 towed, provided the power unit is properly registered under this chapter.  
41 The registration fees for wrecker plates shall be as required in subsection  
42 (1) of this section for a vehicle one (1) and two (2) years old. All other  
43 fees required under chapter 4, title 49, Idaho Code, shall be in addition to  
44 the registration fee and shall be subject to staggered registration for the  
45 purpose of reregistration and notice of expiration.

46 (9) In addition to the annual registration fee in this section, there  
47 shall be an initial program fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) and an an-  
48 nual program fee of fifteen dollars (\$15.00) for all special license plate  
49 programs for those license plates issued pursuant to sections 49-404A,  
50 49-407, 49-408, 49-409, 49-414, 49-416, 49-418 and 49-418D, Idaho Code. For

1 special plates issued pursuant to sections 49-406 and 49-406A, Idaho Code,  
2 there shall be an initial program fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) but  
3 there shall be no annual renewal fee. For special plates issued pursuant  
4 to sections 49-415C, 49-415D, 49-415E, 49-416A, 49-416B, 49-416C, 49-416D,  
5 49-416E, 49-417, 49-417A, 49-417B, 49-417C, 49-417D, 49-417E, 49-418A,  
6 49-418B, 49-418C, 49-418E, 49-419, 49-419A, 49-419B, 49-419C, 49-419D,  
7 49-419E, 49-420, 49-420A, 49-420B, 49-420C, 49-420D, 49-420E, 49-420G,  
8 49-420H, 49-420I, 49-420J, 49-420K, 49-420L and 49-420M, Idaho Code, and any  
9 new special plate program effective on and after January 1, 2013, pursuant  
10 to section 49-402D, Idaho Code, there shall be an initial program fee of  
11 thirty-five dollars (\$35.00) and an annual program fee of twenty-five dol-  
12 lars (\$25.00). The fees contained in this subsection shall be applicable to  
13 all new special plate programs and shall be subject to staggered registra-  
14 tion for the purpose of reregistration and notice of expiration. The initial  
15 program fee and the annual program fee shall be deposited in the state high-  
16 way account and shall be used to fund the cost of administration of special  
17 license plate programs, unless otherwise specified by law.

18 (10) Any vehicle that does not meet federal motor vehicle safety stan-  
19 dards shall not be registered and shall not be permitted to operate on public  
20 highways of the state, as defined in section 40-117, Idaho Code, unless oth-  
21 erwise specifically authorized.

22 (11) In addition to annual registration fees as provided in this sec-  
23 tion, registrants may pay a fee to purchase an Idaho state parks passport  
24 authorizing resident motor vehicle entry into all Idaho state parks. Reg-  
25 istrants may pay the fee for a one (1) year or two (2) year period of time.  
26 The fee shall be ten dollars (\$10.00) for one (1) year and twenty dollars  
27 (\$20.00) for two (2) years. All fees collected pursuant to this subsection  
28 shall be deposited into the park and recreation fund and shall be subject to  
29 appropriation. Fees collected pursuant to this subsection shall not be con-  
30 sidered a motor vehicle registration fee as provided in section 17, article  
31 VII, of the constitution of the state of Idaho.

1 SECTION 2. That Section 49-434, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
 2 amended to read as follows:

3 49-434. OPERATING FEES. (1) There shall be paid on all commercial ve-  
 4 hicles, noncommercial vehicles, and on all farm vehicles having a maximum  
 5 gross weight not in excess of sixty thousand (60,000) pounds, an annual reg-  
 6 istration fee or a staggered registration fee for the purpose of reregistra-  
 7 tion and notice of expiration in accordance with the following schedule.

18 In addition to the registration fees provided for in this subsection, there  
 19 shall be an additional registration fee imposed of fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

20 (2) There shall be paid on all commercial vehicles, irrespective of  
 21 body type, and on all farm vehicles having a maximum gross weight in excess  
 22 of sixty thousand (60,000) pounds, an annual registration fee in the amount  
 23 prescribed by subsection (8) of this section, as applicable.

24 (3) In addition, the annual registration fee for trailers shall be:

- 25 (a) Trailer or semitrailer in a combination of vehicles .....\$15.00
- 26 (b) Rental utility trailer with a gross weight of two thousand (2,000)  
 27 pounds or less .....\$8.00
- 28 (c) Rental utility trailer with a gross weight over two thousand  
 29 (2,000) pounds .....\$15.00

30 (4) As an option to the trailer and semitrailer and rental utility  
 31 trailer annual registrations issued pursuant to subsection (3) of this  
 32 section, the department may provide a nonexpiring plate and registration  
 33 for trailers and semitrailers, and an optional, extended registration for  
 34 rental utility trailers.

35 (a) For trailers and semitrailers, the nonexpiring registration fee  
 36 shall be ninety-nine dollars (\$99.00). The license plate shall remain  
 37 on the trailer or semitrailer until the registration is canceled or re-  
 38 voked. No part of the fee is subject to refund. However, the registrant  
 39 may transfer the nonexpiring plate and registration to another trailer  
 40 or semitrailer titled to the registrant if the original registration  
 41 date is prior to July 1, 2009. The registration document shall be the  
 42 official record of the status of the nonexpiring registration and no  
 43 registration fee shall be required after the initial registration is  
 44 paid. No validation sticker shall be required or issued for such nonex-  
 45 piring license plate.

1 (i) Registration of a trailer or semitrailer based in another ju-  
2 risdiction may be issued when the registrant provides a valid ju-  
3 risdiction title or ownership document and certification state-  
4 ment, and no title transfer will be required.

5 (ii) Periodic verification will be made to confirm ownership sta-  
6 tus. Failure of the owner to comply with the verification request  
7 to confirm ownership within thirty (30) days, shall result in can-  
8 cellation of the permanent plate registration.

9 (b) Idaho based trailer manufacturers may purchase trailer and semi-  
10 trailer registration from the department. The manufacturer may issue  
11 the annual registration to foreign-based purchasers utilizing a manu-  
12 facturer's certificate of origin or manufacturer's statement of origin  
13 as proof of ownership. If the foreign-based purchaser subsequently ob-  
14 tains an Idaho nonexpiring registration as provided in paragraph (a) of  
15 this subsection prior to annual registration expiration, the amount of  
16 the annual registration fee shall be applied to the nonexpiring regis-  
17 tration fee provided that the customer acquires a title for such vehi-  
18 cle.

19 (c) For rental utility trailers, the registrant may prepay the annual  
20 registration for an additional one (1), two (2), three (3) or four (4)  
21 years, but in no event shall the optional registration period extend be-  
22 yond five (5) years. The fee shall be as specified in subsection (3) (b)  
23 or (c) of this section. A pressure-sensitive sticker shall be used to  
24 validate the license plate. The license plate shall become void if the  
25 owner's interest in the rental utility trailer changes during the five  
26 (5) year period. If the owner fails to enter the rental utility trailer  
27 on the annual renewal application during the five (5) year period, the  
28 registration record shall be purged. Any unrenewed plate shall be re-  
29 turned to the department if it is not entered on the renewal applica-  
30 tion.

31 (5) A fleet registration option is available to owners who have  
32 twenty-five (25) or more commercial or farm vehicles or any combination  
33 thereof. Such owners may register all of their company vehicles with the  
34 department in lieu of registering with a county assessor. To qualify the  
35 fleet must be owned and operated under the unified control of one (1) person  
36 and the vehicles must be physically garaged and maintained in two (2) or more  
37 counties. Fleet registration shall not include fleets of rental vehicles.  
38 The department shall provide a registration application to the owner and the  
39 owner shall provide all information that the department determines is neces-  
40 sary. The department shall devise a special license plate numbering system  
41 for fleet-registered vehicles as an alternative to county license plates.  
42 The fleet registration application and all subsequent registration renewals  
43 shall include the physical address where a vehicle is principally used,  
44 garaged and maintained. The fleet owner shall report the physical address to  
45 the department upon initial registration, on each renewal, and at any time a  
46 vehicle registered under this option is permanently transferred to another  
47 location.

48 (6) If the ownership of a vehicle changes during the registration pe-  
49 riod, the original owner may transfer the plate to another vehicle. The re-  
50 maining fee shall be credited against the cost of the new registration. Re-

1 funds may be given for any unexpired portion of the vehicle registration fee  
2 if the plate is not transferred by the owner to another vehicle. Any request  
3 for refund shall include surrender of the license plate, validation sticker  
4 and registration document. Owners of vehicles registered under the inter-  
5 national registration plan may request a refund of the unexpired portion of  
6 the Idaho vehicle registration fee by presenting evidence from the base ju-  
7 risdiction that the license plate, validation sticker and registration doc-  
8 ument have been surrendered. A license plate shall not be transferred to an-  
9 other owner when the ownership of a vehicle changes. The owner shall obtain a  
10 replacement plate, validation sticker if required, and a registration docu-  
11 ment when a plate is lost, destroyed or becomes illegible.

12 (7) An administrative fee of four dollars (\$4.00) shall be paid and de-  
13 posited to the state highway account on all registrations completed by the  
14 department under subsection (1) or (8) (a) of this section. Vehicles regis-  
15 tered under subsection (8) (b) of this section shall pay the fee provided in  
16 section 49-435(2), Idaho Code.

17 (8) There shall be paid on all commercial and farm vehicles having a  
18 maximum gross weight in excess of sixty thousand (60,000) pounds, a regis-  
19 tration fee based upon the maximum gross weight of a vehicle as declared by  
20 the owner and the total number of miles driven on roads and highways in the  
21 state, county, city and highway district systems in Idaho, and if registered  
22 under the international registration plan (IRP), in all other jurisdic-  
23 tions. The appropriate registration fee shall be determined as follows:

24 (a) If the owner registers vehicles under the international registra-  
25 tion plan (IRP), the appropriate mileage column shall be determined by  
26 the total miles an owner operated a fleet of vehicles on roads and high-  
27 ways in the state, county, city and highway district systems in Idaho  
28 and in all other jurisdictions in the preceding year, as defined in sec-  
29 tion 49-117, Idaho Code, and by the maximum gross weight of each vehicle  
30 within a fleet.

31 (b) If the owner registers vehicles under the international registra-  
32 tion plan and determines that the average international registration  
33 plan fleet miles, calculated by dividing the total IRP fleet miles in  
34 all jurisdictions by the number of registered vehicles, is less than  
35 fifty thousand one (50,001) miles, the owner may apply to the depart-  
36 ment for refund of a portion of the registration fees paid, consistent  
37 with the fee schedules set forth in this section. The department shall  
38 provide an application for the refund. An owner making application for  
39 refund under this section shall be subject to auditing as provided in  
40 section 49-439, Idaho Code.

41 (c) If the owner is not registering vehicles under the international  
42 registration plan, the appropriate mileage column shall be determined  
43 by the total miles the owner operated each of the vehicles to be regis-  
44 tered on roads and highways in the state, county, city and highway dis-  
45 trict systems in Idaho in the preceding year and by the maximum gross  
46 weight of each vehicle.

1 In addition to the registration fees provided for in this subsection, there  
2 shall be an additional registration fee imposed of fifteen dollars (\$15.00).

3 (d) In addition to the fees set forth in paragraphs (a) and (c) of this  
4 subsection (8), an owner or operator may purchase a temporary permit as  
5 provided in section 49-432(2), Idaho Code, for operation of a vehicle at  
6 a weight in excess of the current, valid, registered maximum gross vehi-  
7 cle weight. The permit so issued shall be specific to the motor vehicle  
8 to which it is issued. No permit or fee shall be transferable or appor-  
9 tionable to any other vehicle, nor shall any such fee be refundable.

10 (e) Any commercial or farm vehicle registered for more than sixty thou-  
11 sand (60,000) pounds up to one hundred six thousand (106,000) pounds  
12 traveling fewer than two thousand five hundred (2,500) miles annually  
13 on roads and highways in the state, county, city and highway district  
14 systems in Idaho shall pay an annual registration fee of two hundred  
15 fifty-five dollars (\$255). The provisions of section 49-437(2), Idaho  
16 Code, shall not apply to vehicles registered under this subsection  
17 (8) (e).

18 (9) (a) During the first registration year that the fee schedule in sub-  
19 section (8) (c) of this section is in use, an owner shall use the mileage  
20 data from the records used to report the mileage use fee in the immedi-  
21 ately preceding year as the basis for determining the appropriate reg-  
22 istration fee schedule.

23 (b) Any owner who registers a motor vehicle for the first time and who  
24 has no mileage history for the vehicle shall estimate the miles to de-  
25 termine the appropriate fee schedule in subsection (8) (c) of this sec-  
26 tion. When estimating the miles, the owner shall provide a statement on  
27 the application of the method used to arrive at the estimated miles.

28 (c) Any owner using any fee schedule other than the highest fee schedule  
29 under subsection (8) (c) of this section, shall certify at the time of  
30 registration that the miles operated in the preceding year do not exceed  
31 the schedule applied for. Any owner using a fee schedule under subsec-  
32 tion (8) (c) of this section that is less than the highest schedule shall  
33 maintain records to substantiate the use of the schedule as required by  
34 section 49-439, Idaho Code.

35 (10) An owner registering under subsection (8) (a) or (8) (c) of this sec-  
36 tion may elect to pay the full annual registration fee at the time of regis-  
37 tration or renewal of registration, or an owner may pay at least one-quarter  
38 (1/4) of the annual registration fee due. The remainder of the annual Idaho  
39 registration fee shall be paid in three (3) equal installments on dates as  
40 billed by the department.

41 (11) An owner registering or renewing a registration under subsection  
42 (8) (a) of this section electing to use installment payments as provided in  
43 subsection (10) of this section, shall pay all of the fees due to other IRP  
44 jurisdictions in addition to one-quarter (1/4) of the Idaho fee due at the  
45 time of registration or reregistration. The remainder of the annual Idaho  
46 registration fee shall be paid in three (3) equal installments on dates as  
47 billed by the department.

48 (12) If any vehicle or combinations of vehicles haul nonreducible  
49 loads, as authorized under the provisions of section 49-1004, Idaho Code,  
50 and weigh less than the starting weights per axle configuration listed in



1 column 1 of subsection (2), section 49-1004, Idaho Code, then and in that  
2 event there shall be paid for that vehicle, in addition to the other fees  
3 required in this section, an additional use fee of 2.1 mills per mile for each  
4 two thousand (2,000) pounds or fraction thereof of the maximum gross weight  
5 in excess of those set forth in section 49-1001, Idaho Code.

6 SECTION 3. That Chapter 4, Title 49, Idaho Code, be, and the same is  
7 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-  
8 ignated as Section 49-457, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

9 49-457. ELECTRIC VEHICLE FEE -- HYBRID VEHICLE FEE. (1) An electric  
10 vehicle fee of one hundred fifty dollars (\$150) shall be collected in addi-  
11 tion to all other registration fees assessed pursuant to this chapter on each  
12 electric vehicle registered.

13 (2) A hybrid vehicle fee of one hundred dollars (\$100) shall be col-  
14 lected in addition to all other registration fees assessed pursuant to this  
15 chapter on each hybrid vehicle registered.

16 (3) All fees provided for in this section shall be deposited to the  
17 highway distribution account as established in section 40-701, Idaho Code,
