A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND AUTHORIZING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO APPOINT A COMMITTEE TO CONTINUE TO UNDERTAKE AND COMPLETE A STUDY OF ENDOWMENT ASSET ISSUES OF IMPORTANCE TO THE STATE OF IDAHO AND TO MONITOR IMPLEMENTATION OF THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE CALLAN REPORT.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, an Endowment Asset Issues Interim Committee was appointed during the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-second Idaho Legislature to study issues related to action by the Idaho Board of Land Commissioners, the Idaho Department of Lands and the Endowment Fund Investment Board affecting the State of Idaho; and

WHEREAS, issues related to endowment assets continue to arise and pose challenges, opportunities and concerns for the future of Idaho and its citizens' quality of life; and

WHEREAS, Callan Associates was retained by the Land Board in May of 2014 to review the findings and recommendations of the Land Board's subcommittee on endowment governance, to identify any governance shortcomings and make recommendations for improvements, to look at policies and procedures and to conduct an asset allocation study that combined land assets with financial assets; and

WHEREAS, on November 14, 2014, representatives of Callan Associates appeared before the Endowment Asset Issues Interim Committee and reported their findings and recommendations as reflected in its report dated November 7, 2014; and

WHEREAS, the interim committee voted to endorse the Callan Report, findings and recommendations; and

WHEREAS, full implementation of the recommendations in the Callan Report will require action by the Land Board, the Endowment Fund Investment Board, the Idaho Department of Lands and the Legislature over an extended period of years; and

WHEREAS, the interim committee also voted unanimously to request that the Legislative Council appoint another Endowment Asset Issues Interim Committee to continue the work of the interim committee and to monitor implementation of the recommendations of the Callan Report.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and the Senate concurring therein, that the Legislative Council is authorized to appoint a two-year interim committee to continue to undertake and complete a study of endowment asset issues of importance to the State of Idaho and to monitor implementation of the recommendations of the Callan Report of November 7, 2014. The committee will consist of ten legislators, with five from the House of Representatives and five from the Senate, with no less than one legislator from each of the House and Senate minority caucuses. The Legisla-

tive Council shall authorize the committee to receive input, advice and assistance from interested and affected parties who are not members of the Legislature.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council is authorized to also appoint ad hoc legislative members to serve on the committee.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the cochairmen of the committee are authorized to appoint advisors with technical expertise in the governance, management, operation, disposal, preservation and financial performance of endowment assets.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that any advisors to the committee who are not legislative members shall not be reimbursed from legislative funds for per diem, mileage or other expenses and shall not have voting privileges regarding the committee's recommendations and proposed legislation, if any, to the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature.
