2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE IDAHO
3 STATE POLICE RELATING TO RULES OF THE IDAHO PEACE OFFICER STANDARDS AND
4 TRAINING COUNCIL.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule of the
11 Idaho State Police relating to Rules of the Idaho Peace Officer Standards and
12 Training Council is not consistent with legislative intent and should be re-
13 jected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
15 sion of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
16 the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 11.11.01, Idaho State Police,
17 Rules of the Idaho Peace Officer Standards and Training Council, Section
18 052., Subsection 02., only, adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number
19 11-1101-1403, be, and the same is hereby rejected and declared null, void and
20 of no force and effect.
