SENATE BILL NO. 1064

BY COMMERCE AND HUMAN RESOURCES COMMITTEE

AN ACT

RELATING TO COSMETICIANS; AMENDING SECTION 54-805, IDAHO CODE, TO REVISE RE-
QUIREMENTS FOR LICENSURE AS A REGISTERED COSMETOLOGIST.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. That Section 54-805, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
amended to read as follows:

54-805. REQUIREMENTS FOR LICENSE. Except as herein otherwise pro-
vided, the following shall be considered minimum requirements for license in
the respective categories, and all applicants shall be of good moral charac-
ter and temperate habits:

(1) As a registered cosmetologist:

(a) Be sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) years of age.

(b) Completion of two (2) years' high school education or its equiva-
lent.

(c) Graduation from and completion of a ~~two~~ one thousand six hundred
(2,01,600) hour course of instruction in a school of cosmetology, or a
four thousand (4,000) hour course of instruction as an apprentice cov-
ering all phases of the practice of cosmetology. Nothing contained in
this paragraph shall prevent a cosmetology school from providing addi-
tional hours of training.

(d) Successful passage of an examination for cosmetologist conducted
by or acceptable to the board.

(2) As an instructor of cosmetology, nail technology, esthetics or
electrology: twelve (12) semester college credit hours or equivalent as
approved by the board or successful completion of the examination required
by board rules, and

(a) Hold a current license as a cosmetologist, nail technologist, es-
thetician or electrologist and satisfactory completion of a six (6)
month teacher's course of instruction in a school of cosmetology, or

(b) Two (2) years' experience as a licensed cosmetologist, nail tech-
nologist, esthetician or electrologist in a registered cosmetological
establishment and a three (3) month teacher's course of instruction in a
school of cosmetology, or

(c) Five (5) years' experience as a licensed cosmetologist, nail tech-
nologist, esthetician or electrologist immediately preceding the ap-
plication for license.

(3) As an apprentice:

(a) Be sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) years of age.

(b) Have completed at least two (2) years of high school education or
its equivalent.

(4) As a nail technician:

(a) Be sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) years of age.

- 1 (b) Have completed at least two (2) years of high school education or
2 its equivalent.
- 3 (c) Have completed and graduated from at least a four hundred (400)
4 hour course of instruction and graduated from such training in a board
5 approved school, or an eight hundred (800) hour course of instruction
6 as an apprentice in a specified cosmetological establishment under the
7 direct personal supervision of a licensed cosmetology instructor, who
8 shall have at least one (1) licensed nail technician on-site in the
9 specified cosmetological establishment for each student being trained.
- 10 (d) Successful passage of an examination for nail technician conducted
11 by or acceptable to the board.
- 12 (5) As an electrologist:
- 13 (a) Be sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) years of age.
- 14 (b) Have completed at least two (2) years of high school education or
15 its equivalent.
- 16 (c) Have completed and graduated from at least an eight hundred (800)
17 hour course of instruction and graduated from such training in a school
18 approved by the board to teach electrology, or a one thousand six hun-
19 dred (1,600) hour course of instruction as an apprentice in a specified
20 cosmetological establishment under the direct personal supervision of
21 a licensed electrologist instructor, who shall have at least one (1)
22 licensed electrologist on-site in the specified cosmetological estab-
23 lishment as established by board rules.
- 24 (d) Successfully passed an examination for electrologist conducted by
25 or acceptable to the board.
- 26 (6) As an esthetician:
- 27 (a) Be sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) years of age.
- 28 (b) Have completed at least two (2) years of high school education or
29 its equivalent.
- 30 (c) Have completed and graduated from at least a six hundred (600) hour
31 course of instruction for such in a school approved by the board to teach
32 esthetics or a one thousand two hundred (1,200) hour course of instruc-
33 tion as an apprentice in a specified cosmetological establishment un-
34 der the direct personal supervision of a licensed cosmetology instruc-
35 tor, who shall have at least one (1) licensed esthetician on-site in the
36 specified cosmetological establishment for each student being trained.
- 37 (d) Successfully passed an examination for esthetician conducted by or
38 acceptable to the board.
- 39 (7) As a haircutter:
- 40 (a) Be sixteen and one-half (16 1/2) years of age.
- 41 (b) Have completed at least two (2) years of high school education or
42 its equivalent.
- 43 (c) Have completed and graduated from at least a nine hundred (900) hour
44 course of instruction for such in a school approved by the board to teach
45 haircutting.
- 46 (d) Successfully passed an examination for haircutter conducted by or
47 acceptable to the board.
