SENATE BILL NO. 1092

BY LOCAL GOVERNMENT AND TAXATION COMMITTEE

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO KNIVES; AMENDING CHAPTER 33, TITLE 18, IDAHO CODE, BY THE ADDI-
2 TION OF A NEW SECTION 18-3326, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT A POLITICAL
3 SUBDIVISION SHALL NOT ENACT CERTAIN RULES, ORDINANCES OR TAXES RELATING
4 TO KNIVES AND TO PROVIDE THAT CERTAIN RULES AND ORDINANCES FROM A POLIT-
5 ICAL SUBDIVISION SHALL BE NULL AND VOID.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Chapter 33, Title 18, Idaho Code, be, and the same is
9 hereby amended by the addition thereto of a NEW SECTION, to be known and des-
10 ignated as Section 18-3326, Idaho Code, and to read as follows:

11 18-3326. CONSISTENCY IN KNIFE REGULATION. (1) Except as in accordance
12 with sections 18-3302 and 18-3302A, Idaho Code, a city, county or other po-
13 litical subdivision of this state shall not enact any ordinance, rule or tax
14 relating to the transportation, possession, carrying, sale, transfer, pur-
15 chase, gift, devise, licensing, registration or use of a knife or knife mak-
16 ing components in this state.

17 (2) A city, county or other political subdivision of this state shall
18 not enact any rule or ordinance relating to the manufacture of a knife that
19 is more restrictive than any rule or ordinance relating to the manufacture of
20 any other commercial goods.

21 (3) Except as in accordance with sections 18-3302 and 18-3302A, Idaho
22 Code, any rule or ordinance of a city, county or political subdivision of
23 this state that contradicts the provisions of this section shall be null,
24 void and of no force and effect.
