SENATE BILL NO. 1173

AN ACT

1 REDUCING THE APPROPRIATION TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR FISCAL YEAR 2015;
2 APPROPRIATING ADDITIONAL MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR FISCAL
3 YEAR 2015; APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE DEPARTMENT OF LABOR FOR FIS-
4 CAL YEAR 2016; LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT
5 POSITIONS; PROVIDING AN APPROPRIATION AND TRANSFER OF MONEYS TO THE
6 WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT TRAINING FUND; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT FOR
7 LOCAL DEPARTMENT OF LABOR OFFICES; PROVIDING LEGISLATIVE INTENT ON AC-
8 TIVITIES OF THE WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT TRAINING FUND; AND DECLARING AN
9 EMERGENCY.

11 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

12 SECTION 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary,
13 the appropriation made to the Department of Labor, for the Employment Ser-
14 vices Program in Section 1, Chapter 301, Laws of 2014, from the Employment
15 Security Special Administration Fund, is hereby reduced by \$3,000,000 for
16 operating expenditures, for the period July 1, 2014, through June 30, 2015.

17 SECTION 2. In addition to the appropriation made in Section 1, Chap-
18 ter 301, Laws of 2014, and any other appropriation provided for by law, there
19 is hereby appropriated to the Department of Labor, for the Employment Ser-
20 vices Program, the following amounts to be expended for the designated ex-
21 pense classes, from the listed funds for the period July 1, 2014, through
22 June 30, 2015:

11 SECTION 4. FTP AUTHORIZATION. In accordance with Section 67-3519,
12 Idaho Code, the Department of Labor is authorized no more than seven hundred
13 (700) full-time equivalent positions at any point during the period July 1,
14 2015, through June 30, 2016, unless specifically authorized by the Governor.
15 The Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee will be notified promptly of any
16 increased positions so authorized.

17 SECTION 5. Notwithstanding Section 72-519, Idaho Code, on July 1, 2015,
18 or as soon thereafter as is practicable, the State Controller shall transfer
19 the sum of three million dollars (\$3,000,000) from the Industrial Adminis-
20 tration Fund to the Workforce Development Training Fund for the purpose of
21 providing Industry Sector grants.

22 SECTION 6. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that
23 during the time period July 1, 2015, to June 30, 2016, the Department of Labor
24 shall maintain the same number of local offices and provide the same or sim-
25 ilar level of service as provided on July 1, 2014. Further, the Department
26 of Labor shall report to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Committee, at the
27 committee's 2015 fall interim meeting, and detail the gap between necessary
28 resources and the current level of service to maintain the same number of lo-
29 cal offices. Additionally, the department report shall include recommenda-
30 tions to fund these services.

31 SECTION 7. LEGISLATIVE INTENT. It is the intent of the Legislature that
32 during the Second Regular Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the
33 Department of Labor shall report to the Joint Finance-Appropriations Com-
34 mittee on activities of the Workforce Development Training Fund. The re-
35 port shall include results of employment for enrollees in the program, their
36 wages before and after training, duration of employment, relation of train-
37 ing to field of employment, and detail how the money was expended.

38 SECTION 8. An emergency existing therefor, which emergency is hereby
39 declared to exist, Sections 1 and 2 of this act shall be in full force and ef-
40 fect on and after passage and approval.
