A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE DOCKET OF  
3 THE IDAHO STATE DEPARTMENT OF AGRICULTURE RELATING TO RULES GOVERNING  
4 LIVESTOCK DEALERS, BUYING STATIONS, AND LIVESTOCK TRADER LOTS.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive  
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the  
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-  
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that a certain rule docket  
11 of the Idaho State Department of Agriculture relating to Rules Governing  
12 Livestock Dealers, Buying Stations, and Livestock Trader Lots is not consis-  
13 tent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular  
15 Session of the Sixty-third Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of  
16 Representatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 02.04.28, the Idaho State  
17 Department of Agriculture, Rules Governing Livestock Dealers, Buying Sta-  
18 tions, and Livestock Trader Lots, adopted as a pending rule under Docket  
19 Number 02-0428-1401, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the same is  
20 hereby rejected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
