**RS 23384:** **Rep. Dayley** presented **RS 23384**, a proposed Joint Memorial to urge the members of the United States House of Representatives and the United States Senate to transmit to the President their written declaration of opposition to a proposed federal regulation. He stated there are 18 other states currently in the process of proposing the same type of legislation in their states and a total of 30 states have agreed to follow suit.
