Ms. Hyde stated the organization promotes career development in rangelands with the University of Idaho. Ms. Hyde stated the Rangeland Resource program provides great rangeland experience for FFA and 4-H students. Ms. Hyde provides teacher workshops, but most of the curriculum is for kindergarten through 12th grade. Ms. Hyde stated the internet, U-tube, and social media have been an effective resource for education and distribution of the IRRC curriculum.
