The amendment also distinguishes a charitable contribution transfer to a qualified religious or charitable entity or organization not exceeding fifteen percent of the transferor's gross income. He said the sponsor of the bill supported the changes.
- MOTION: Rep. Rusche made a motion to concur with the amendments made in the Senate to H 92 aa, aaS. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Clow will sponsor the bill on the floor.
