Chairman Loertscher called the meeting to order at 8:35 a.m.
- RS 23947:** **Rep. Palmer** presented **RS 23947**, a concurrent resolution that rejects a rule of the Idaho Transportation Department requiring automobile dealers to keep certain hours in their businesses.
Rep. Sims invoked Rule 38 stating a possible conflict of interest but stated she would be voting on the legislation.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Jordan** made a motion to introduce **RS 23947** and recommend it be sent directly to the Second Reading Calendar. **Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Palmer** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- H 319:** **Rep. Batt** presented **H 319**, an annual bill that continues certain administrative rules and allows them to stay in full force and effect until July 1, 2016.
- MOTION:** **Rep. McCrostie** made a motion to send **H 319** to the floor with a **DO PASS** recommendation. **Motion carried by voice vote. Chairman Loertscher** will sponsor the bill on the floor.
- H 155aaS:** **Rep. Bateman** presented **H 155aaS**, legislation that increases the penalties for violation of the State Open Meeting Law. He stated the Senate has made amendments to the bill.
- MOTION:** **Rep. Luker** made a motion to **HOLD H 155aaS** in committee for a time certain of one day. He spoke to the motion and stated he would like to ask questions of the Senate regarding the changes. **Motion carried by voice vote.**
- MOTION:** **Rep. McCrostie** made a motion for reconsideration of **S 1146aa**.
There was a discussion on whether the motion was proper. **Chairman Loertscher** explained the motion was proper but he wouldn't allow any other testimony on the bill. He stated if the motion for reconsideration fails, the legislation could not be brought up again.
- VOTE ON
MOTION:** A roll call vote was requested. **Motion carried by a vote of 12 AYE, 4 NAY, 1 Absent/excused. Voting in favor of the motion: Chairman Loertscher, Reps. Andrus, Sims, Barbieri, McMillan, Bateman, Cheatham, Nielsen, Smith, Jordan, McCrostie and Wintrow. Voting in opposition to the motion: Reps. Batt, Luker, Palmer and Holtzclaw. Rep. Crane was absent/excused.**
- MOTION:** **Rep. Andrus** made a motion to **HOLD S 1146aa** in committee for a time certain of one day. **Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Barbieri** requested to be recorded as voting **NAY**.

ADJOURN: There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting was adjourned at 9:13 a.m.
