**Chairman Perry** called the meeting to order at 10:02 A.M.  
**MOTION:** **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to approve the minutes of the April 2, 2015 meeting. **Motion carried by voice vote.**  
**RS 23957:** **Sen. Davis** presented **RS 23957**. The purpose of the proposed legislation is to remove outdated language dealing with the publishing and distribution of the Session Laws.  
**MOTION:** **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 23957**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**  
**RS 23958:** **Rep. Palmer** presented **RS 23958**. This proposed legislation calls for a buyout of Federal Funds between the Local Highway Jurisdictions and the Idaho Transportation Department, that are non-mandated for the local system. The Local Highway Technical Assistance Council (LHTAC) will continue to provide technical assistance to local jurisdictions, but will no longer receive federal aid to administer it. This approach will reduce administrative costs by LHTAC, and give local jurisdictions more flexibility with their funding for roads.  
**MOTION:** **Rep. Crane** made a motion to introduce **RS 23958**. **Motion carried by voice vote.** **Reps. Rusche, Erpelding and Pence** requested they be recorded as voting **NAY**.  
**RS 23759:** **Bill Litster**, Idaho citizen presented **RS 23759**. The proposed legislation clarifies automobile underinsurance coverage will be "excess" (in addition to). Defining it as excess gives the consumer genuine "What you buy is what you get" underinsurance, which will block post-accident offsets.  
**MOTION:** **Rep. Moyle** made a motion to introduce **RS 23759**. **Motion carried by voice vote.**  
**ADJOURN:** There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 10:37 A.M.
