**Chairman Perry** called the meeting to order at 8:25 a.m.

**RS 23967:** **Rep. Wills** presented **RS 23967** to the committee and asked to be allowed to refer to other legislation in his testimony. With no objection from the committee, Rep. Wills said this new bill in RS form keeps the mechanics of **S 1067** relating to the Uniform Interstate Family Support Act (UIFSA) of 2008. He said this bill will help in the effort to allow for the collection of child support payments from non-custodial parents, not only within the United States, but also in foreign countries. Rep. Wills stated the changes proposed in this legislation address concerns that were raised regarding state sovereignty, security and personal information.

In response to questions from the committee, **Rep. Wills** confirmed that the concerns raised were taken care of with the new legislation. He also stated after the regular session he and others, including the Department of Health and Welfare were able to work to make amendments in the appropriate sections of Code. Further comments from the committee expressed concerns with the process and misinformation that may have been given by the Department. Other comments from the committee were in support of the legislation.

**MOTION:** **Rep. Rusche** made a motion to introduce **RS 23967**. **Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Moyle** requested to be recorded as voting **NAY**.

**ADJOURN:** There being no further business to come before the committee, the meeting adjourned at 8:37 a.m.
