

Proposed authorization regarding receipt of honorarium

"A legislator filling a legislative position on a state board or commission is authorized to receive payment or honorarium in the same manner as his or her fellow board or commission members. The payment or honorarium may be in addition to the salary established for each member of the Legislature. Provided however, that if the limitations of Idaho Code section 59-102 apply, it shall be unlawful for the legislative member to receive any such payment or honorarium."

For purposes of this authorization, the term "legislative position" refers to instances where a state board or commission is required to have one or more legislative members and the legislator is appointed to satisfy that requirement.
