I am sending the below in response to the outstanding question to parks. Please let me know if this meets your needs.

When our user groups proposed to eliminate the proration on boats, we supported the effort because we felt it had the potential to increase revenue by about \$50,000. That was based on an average of the previous two years (we looked at each customer who paid a prorated fee over that two year period and calculated the difference between what they paid and what they would have paid if they paid a full year). However, when we look at our actual revenues since that change took effect, we cannot identify a specific, correlated increase. To be bluntly truthful, there is simply no way to factor out all of the seasonal, economic, and registration processing issues to result in a pure comparison of prorating before and after.

Please note that the invasive species fee was never prorated, only the boat registration portion. The \$10 invasive species fee was applied to all boat registrations regardless. In our last presentation, we only anticipated prorating the two existing stickers--that is the "non-motorized" sticker and the "not registered in Idaho" sticker. If the committee were to consider prorating the fee for in-state boat registrations, that would raise significant concerns related to not only programming and training, but also the strict Coast Guard regulations related to registrations. It may be best to assume that we would need to adopt a third sticker program at that point.
