

State Obligation for Contracts

- I. The following may obligate the state on a contract:
 - State agencies (subject to the State Procurement Act)
 - Constitutional officers (not subject)
 - Legislative branch (not subject)
 - Judicial branch (not subject)
 - Department of Lands (not subject)
 - State Lottery (not subject)

- II. The following may not obligate the state on a contract:
 - Any entity defined in code as an “independent public body corporate and politic”
 - Most agricultural commissions and similar commissions (probably – statutes exempt the state from the “acts or omissions” of the commissions)

- III. It is unclear whether the following may obligate the state on a contract:
 - Independent Living Council (not subject)
 - Idaho Bureau of Educational Services for the Deaf and the Blind (not subject)
 - Idaho Digital Learning Academy (not subject)
