RS 24248:	<b>Rep. Kelley Packer</b> , District 28, presented <b>RS 24248</b> , a Concurrent Resolution recognizing the benefits of fluoride, a natural occurrence in Idaho drinking water. This is not a mandate, it simply acknowledges Idaho's important role in the discovery of fluoride and the resultant oral health benefit.
MOTION:	<b>Rep. Rusche</b> made a motion to introduce <b>RS 24248</b> and recommend it be sent directly to the Second Reading Calendar.
	<b>Rep. Rusche</b> commented the mid-1900 fluoride discussions presented irrefutable data that fluoride prevents infections, cavities, and promotes strong teeth. It also provides a local policy option.
VOTE ON MOTION:	Chairman Wood called for a vote on the motion to introduce RS 24248 and recommend it be sent directly to the Second Reading Calendar. Motion carried by voice vote. Rep. Packer will sponsor the bill on the floor.
