This letter is in support of Senate Bill 1291, also known as The Adult Degree Completion Scholarship.

In the College of Southern Idaho's eight-county service region, business and industry depend on a trained and skilled workforce, and many employees are graduates of one of CSI's programs, whether that be a professional technical program with a degree or certificate or whether that be post-employment non-degree training.
