

## STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

### RS24856

In response to a contested case brought to the Public Works Contractor Licensing Board regarding what constitutes "acting in the capacity of a construction manager", DBS proposes to amend the existing language to provide clearer statutory language and to move existing authority from the board to the administrator in order to coincide with the authority of the administrator in Title 54, Chapter 19, and to expedite and better address disputes that may be brought forward, without requiring formal board action.

### FISCAL NOTE

There is no significant fiscal impact to the dedicated fund. The proposed legislation change is directed at enhanced definition of terms and a shift in authority. It will not modify public works license fees which are the only revenue source for the effected fund.
