

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

The secretary will need to collect specific, personal information from consumers to create a user account through which users can access an online filing system. This information will be used for verification and validation of a user on that account, and for communicating with that consumer should the consumer forget a password, or should that user choose to receive electronic notifications. Current statute does not directly authorize the secretary of state to collect personal information for this purpose, or exempt this information from public records requests. Thus, the Secretary of State would like to amend Idaho Code Section 74-106 and add to Chapter 9 Title 67 a new section designated as 67-906, to specifically authorize the collection of this information and maintain its confidentiality.

FISCAL NOTE

There will be no direct impact to the general fund due to this legislation, because the cost of the filing system is already covered under S1020.
