A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DIVI-
3 SION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO IDAHO MINIMUM SAFETY STANDARDS AND
4 PRACTICES FOR LOGGING, RECOMMENDED SAFETY PROGRAM.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
11 Division of Building Safety relating to Idaho Minimum Safety Standards and
12 Practices for Logging - Recommended Safety Program are not consistent with
13 legislative intent and should be rejected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
15 sion of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and
16 the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.08.16, Division of Building
17 Safety, Idaho Minimum Safety Standards and Practices for Logging - Recom-
18 mended Safety Program, Section 010., Subsection 01.a., adopted as a pending
19 rule under Docket Number 07-0816-1601, only, be, and the same is hereby re-
20 jected and declared null, void and of no force and effect.
