

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

**RS24970C1**

This legislation provides for the issuance of a driving privilege card to those who have not been assigned a social security number. With certain limitations, the driving privilege card would substitute for a class D driver's license. The driving privilege card must clearly display that it is "FOR DRIVING PRIVILEGES ONLY – NOT VALID FOR IDENTIFICATION" and it may not be accepted as proof of personal identification by a governmental entity. Driving privilege cards shall expire each year on the birth date of the applicant.

**FISCAL NOTE**

Applicants for driving privilege cards will pay the same fees as those applying for a class D driver's license. If existing fees are not sufficient to cover costs, the Idaho Transportation Department may, by rule, implement a surcharge to cover those costs in excess of fee revenues. The Department estimates an initial appropriation of at least \$107,000 in General Funds will be needed for FY 2018 to cover start up costs, which would be paid back to the General Fund from surcharge revenues.
