

**STATEMENT OF PURPOSE**

**RS24825**

The amendment authorizes the board to require mediation of disputes between licensed land surveyors. The purpose is to reduce the prospect of litigation between property owners related to boundary disputes based on differing placement of corners by land surveyors.

**FISCAL NOTE**

This legislation will have no fiscal impact to the general fund or the Board of Professional Engineers and Professional Land Surveyor's dedicated fund. It has no fiscal impact because the Board has no direct involvement in the mediation between land surveyors except to require them to engage a mediator to resolve their disputes. The Act does not create any new state program and does not compel any state action.
