We want to express our strong support for S1103, introduced by Senator Mary Souza. It was very frustrating to see a ridiculously small turnout for our School board elections held in May. School board elections are vitally important to the whole education process, and by moving those elections to the general elections held in November, we would be guaranteed that there would be a much larger turnout. We believe that a larger turnout would represent a much more accurate vote of the electorate.

We also like the idea of giving the local boards the option to either conduct the election either by moving all the seats to a district-wide situation, or to continue to utilize "zone voting".

These changes are long overdue so we want you and your committee to understand that we support this bill in the strongest terms possible, as do many, many of our constituents.
