2 RELATING TO CAMPAIGN FINANCE; AMENDING SECTION 67-6625A, IDAHO CODE, TO RE-
3 VISE THE CONDITIONS UNDER WHICH THE SECRETARY OF STATE MAY NOT WAIVE THE
4 FEE FOR THE LATE FILING OF CAMPAIGN FINANCE REPORTS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-6625A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-6625A. LATE FILING OF STATEMENT OR REPORT -- FEES. (1) If any per-
9 son fails to file a report or statement on or before a specified date, he
10 shall be liable to the secretary of state in ~~an~~ the amount of fifty dollars
11 (\$50.00) per day after the deadline until the statement or report is filed,
12 ~~to the secretary of state~~. Liability need not be enforced by the secretary
13 of state if on an impartial basis he determines that the late filing was not
14 willful and that enforcement of the liability will not further the purposes
15 of the act, except that no liability shall be waived if a statement or re-
16 port is not filed within ~~five (5) days~~ twenty-four (24) hours after receiv-
17 ing ~~written~~ electronic notice of the filing requirement from the secretary
18 of state.

19 (2) The remedy provided in this section is cumulative and does not ex-
20 clude any other remedy or penalty prescribed in section 67-6625, Idaho Code.
