1 AN ACT  
2 RELATING TO ELECTION CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES; AMENDING SEC-  
3 TION 67-6625A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE SECRETARY OF STATE SHALL  
4 PROVIDE NOTIFICATION TO A CANDIDATE OR TREASURER IN CERTAIN INSTANCES.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 67-6625A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 67-6625A. LATE FILING OF STATEMENT OR REPORT -- FEES. (1) If any person  
9 fails to file a report or statement on or before a specified date, he shall be  
10 liable to the secretary of state in an amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per  
11 day after the deadline until the statement or report is filed, ~~to the secre-~~  
12 ~~tary of state. Liability need not be enforced by t~~ The secretary of state if  
13 on an impartial basis he determines that the late shall notify a candidate or  
14 treasurer of a political candidate who fails to file a statement or report by  
15 telephone or electronically within twenty-four (24) hours of not filing was  
16 not willful and that enforcement of the liability will not further the pur-  
17 poses of the act, except that no liability shall be waived if a statement or  
18 report is not filed within five (5) days after receiving written notice of  
19 the filing requirement from the secretary of state.

20 (2) The remedy provided in this section is cumulative and does not ex-  
21 clude any other remedy or penalty prescribed in section 67-6625, Idaho Code.
