1 AN ACT  
2 RELATING TO ELECTION CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES AND LOBBYISTS;  
3 AMENDING SECTION 67-6625A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE THAT THE SECRETARY  
4 OF STATE OR COUNTY CLERK SHALL PROVIDE NOTIFICATION TO PERSONS WHO HAVE  
5 FAILED TO FILE A REQUIRED STATEMENT OR REPORT.

6 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 SECTION 1. That Section 67-6625A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
8 amended to read as follows:

9 67-6625A. LATE FILING OF STATEMENT OR REPORT -- FEES. (1) If any person  
10 fails to file a report or statement required under this chapter on or before  
11 a specified date, he shall be liable to the secretary of state for deposit in  
12 the general fund in an the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per day beginning  
13 immediately after the deadline until the statement or report is filed, to  
14 the secretary of state. Liability need not be enforced by t The secretary  
15 of state if on an impartial basis he determines that the late filing was not  
16 willful and that enforcement of the liability will not further the purposes  
17 of the act, except that no liability shall be waived if a statement or report  
18 is not filed within five (5) days after receiving written notice of the fil-  
19 ing requirement from the secretary of state or the county clerk shall notify  
20 the person and his treasurer, if any, that a fine has been assessed and will  
21 continue to accrue until the report or statement has been filed. The noti-  
22 fication shall be made by telephone or electronic means within twenty-four  
23 (24) hours of the missed filing deadline.

24 (2) The remedy provided in this section is cumulative and does not ex-  
25 clude any other remedy or penalty prescribed in section 67-6625, Idaho Code.
