2 RELATING TO ELECTION CAMPAIGN CONTRIBUTIONS AND EXPENDITURES AND LOBBYISTS;
3 AMENDING SECTION 67-6625A, IDAHO CODE, TO PROVIDE FOR A LATE FILING FEE
4 INCREASE AFTER FIVE DAYS FOLLOWING A MISSED DEADLINE AND TO PROVIDE THAT
5 THE SECRETARY OF STATE OR COUNTY CLERK SHALL PROVIDE NOTIFICATION TO
6 PERSONS WHO HAVE FAILED TO FILE A REQUIRED STATEMENT OR REPORT.

7 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

8 SECTION 1. That Section 67-6625A, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
9 amended to read as follows:

10 67-6625A. LATE FILING OF STATEMENT OR REPORT -- FEES. (1) If any person
11 fails to file a report or statement required under this chapter on or before
12 a specified date, he shall be liable to the secretary of state for deposit in
13 the general fund in an the amount of fifty dollars (\$50.00) per day beginning
14 immediately after the deadline until the statement or report is filed, to
15 the secretary of state or until five (5) days have passed, whichever occurs
16 first. On the sixth day following the missed filing deadline and each day
17 thereafter until the statement or report is filed, the late filing fee shall
18 be assessed at two hundred fifty dollars (\$250) per day for deposit in the
19 general fund. Liability need not be enforced by t The secretary of state if
20 on an impartial basis he determines that the late filing was not willful and
21 that enforcement of the liability will not further the purposes of the act,
22 except that no liability shall be waived if a statement or report is not filed
23 within five (5) days after receiving written notice of the filing require-
24 ment from the secretary of state or county clerk shall notify the person and
25 his treasurer, if any, that a fine has been assessed and will continue to ac-
26 cruce until the report or statement has been filed. The notification shall be
27 made by telephone or electronic means within twenty-four (24) hours of the
28 missed filing deadline.

29 (2) The remedy provided in this section is cumulative and does not ex-
30 clude any other remedy or penalty prescribed in section 67-6625, Idaho Code.
