DRKMF022	Late filing fee, notice	Formerly draft 011. Added provision that late fee goes to General Fund; that the fee is assessed immediately after the filing deadline, and provides for telephone or email notice by the Secretary of State to the candidate and treasurer of ongoing fine.	
DRKMF023	Consolidate campaign finance reporting, database	Formerly draft 012. Removed provision regarding late filing fees.	
DRKMF024	Late filing fee, incremental increase	Formerly draft 011. Same as draft 022 above, except increases the late filing fee to \$250 per day after five days.	
DRKMF026	Include local elections in campaign reporting	Formerly draft 013. Correction to heading of Section 7 only.	
DRKMF027	Disclosures by PACS	Requires registration of PAC's board of directors; restricts PAC to PAC transfers over \$1000 absent such disclosure.	
DRKMF030	Timing of campaign finance reports	Formerly draft 014. Changes the due date of unexpended balances or campaign debt to be consistent with other campaign finance report due dates.	
DRKMF032	Electioneering communications (EC)	Revises electioneering communication time period; revises newspaper exception to EC; defines social media; revises the due date of EC and IE reports to be the same as candidate and political committee reports; requires an authority line in EC.	
DRKMF033	Independent expenditures (IE) and Electioneering communications (EC)	Revises electioneering communication time period; revises newspaper exception to EC; defines social media; revises the due date of IE reports to be the same as candidate and political committee reports; and requires donor information for IE.	
DRKMF036	ALL IN ONE!	This draft combines drafts 022, 023, 026, 030, 032 and 033.
