

**Idaho** - The Boards served by the Idaho Bureau of Occupational Licenses are all self-supporting and operate on dedicated funds which come primarily from licensing and registration fees. Such Boards maintain a recommended fund balance equivalent to 100-150% of their annual budget. When balances exceed that amount, boards propose rule changes to lower fees, leaving more money in the hands of licensees. There have been a number of such fee reductions in recent years.
