

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS25915

This resolution will reject three subsections of a final rule found in IDAPA 58.01.08, Section 552., Subsections 06.c., 06.e., and 07., only. Department of Environmental Quality, Rules Governing Public Drinking Water Systems.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no fiscal impact to the Idaho General or Dedicated funds. The cost associated with back-flow device testing is an unfunded mandate that is the responsibility of the property owner with irrigation systems connected to public water systems. The cost for annual testing for a homeowner will vary by jurisdiction, with estimates of \$25 -35 per year for each residential test. Local Governments may see reduced administrative costs to monitor the annual testing.
