2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND RECOGNIZING AND EXTENDING CONGRAT-  
3 ULATIONS AND BEST WISHES FOR SUCCESS TO THE IDAHOANS SELECTED TO REPRESENT  
4 THE UNITED STATES AT THE 2018 WINTER OLYMPICS.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Winter Olympics in PyeongChang, South Korea, will feature  
7 premier athletes from around the world; and

8 WHEREAS, on the snowy slopes and trails or on icy surfaces, approxi-  
9 mately 240 extraordinary Americans will represent our nation with pride as  
10 members of the U.S. Olympic team; and

11 WHEREAS, Idaho is internationally known as a winter sports destination  
12 with a rich winter sports history, including the nation's first destination  
13 ski resort, and it is not surprising that five athletes from the Gem State are  
14 members of this impressive team; and

15 WHEREAS, those Idaho athletes selected for membership on the 2018 U.S.  
16 Winter Olympic team are Hilary Knight of Sun Valley, a two-time Olympian and  
17 two-time silver medalist in ice hockey; Jessika Jenson of Rigby, a returning  
18 Olympian in snowboarding and competing in the slopestyle and big air events;  
19 Chase Josey of Hailey, debuting in the halfpipe event of snowboarding; and  
20 Nick Cunningham, a former Boise State University track athlete and two-time  
21 Olympian, and Sam Michener, a former University of Idaho athlete, in his  
22 Olympic debut, competing as members of the USA bobsled team.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-  
24 sion of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and  
25 the Senate concurring therein, that we recognize and extend congratulations  
26 and best wishes for success to the Idahoans selected to represent the United  
27 States at the 2018 Winter Olympics.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Chief Clerk of the House be directed to  
29 send a copy of this resolution to each of the Idahoans on the U.S. Winter  
30 Olympic team.
