SENATE BILL NO. 1217

2 RELATING TO FISH AND GAME; AMENDING SECTION 36-301, IDAHO CODE, TO AUTHORIZE  
3 THE DIRECTOR OF THE IDAHO DEPARTMENT OF FISH AND GAME TO COLLECT CERTAIN  
4 CREDIT CARD FEES.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 36-301, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby  
7 amended to read as follows:

8 36-301. FORMS OF LICENSES -- PRINTING -- CHARGEABLE TO DIRECTOR. (a)  
9 Computerized licensing system. The fish and game commission shall prescribe  
10 by rule:

11 1. The procedures for the issuance of licenses and applications by a  
12 computerized licensing system.

13 2. The criteria for authorizing a person as a license vendor. In de-  
14 veloping the criteria, the commission shall consider the cost to the  
15 state to install and maintain a license vendor and the public's need  
16 to be able to reasonably obtain the necessary license. The criteria  
17 should include, but are not limited to, the remoteness of the location;  
18 availability of licenses in the area; angling and hunting supplies and  
19 services at the location; distance to the next closest license vendor;  
20 and the number of licenses issued at the location.

21 (b) Forms. The forms of the various fishing, hunting and trapping li-  
22 censes and related applications shall be determined by the director. The  
23 director shall authorize printing the licenses and related applications as  
24 may be required from time to time and shall supervise the selling of same  
25 throughout the state.

26 (c) Accountability. The director shall manage the issuance of such li-  
27 censes and be accountable for moneys received therefor. The director is au-  
28 thorized to collect a credit card fee, commensurate with the rate charged to  
29 the agency by the credit card vendor, from persons using a credit card to pur-  
30 chase any licenses, related applications, and materials pursuant to section  
31 59-1012, Idaho Code, at fish and game offices and fish and game-sponsored  
32 events.
