SENATE BILL NO. 1266

AN ACT

1 RELATING TO EDUCATION; AMENDING SECTION 33-512C, IDAHO CODE, TO REMOVE THE
2 REQUIREMENT THAT TWO SEMESTER CREDITS OF MATHEMATICS MUST BE TAKEN IN
3 THE FINAL YEAR OF HIGH SCHOOL AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

5 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 SECTION 1. That Section 33-512C, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
7 amended to read as follows:

8 33-512C. ENCOURAGEMENT OF GIFTED STUDENTS. If a student completes any
9 required high school course with a grade of C or higher before entering grade
10 ~~nine (9)~~, if that course meets the same standards that are required in high
11 school, if the course is taught by a properly certified teacher who meets the
12 federal definition of being highly qualified for the course being taught and
13 if the school providing the course is accredited as recognized by the state
14 board, the student shall be given a grade for the successful completion of
15 that course, and such grade and the number of credit hours assigned to the
16 course shall be transferred to the student's high school transcript. ~~Two (2)~~
17 ~~semester credits of the required six (6) semester mathematics credits must~~
18 ~~be taken in the final year of high school.~~ The provisions of this section do
19 not apply to senior projects.
