A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND PROVIDING FOR THE AMENDMENT OF JOINT
RULE 4 OF THE JOINT RULES OF THE SENATE AND THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES
OF THE STATE OF IDAHO.

Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

WHEREAS, the Senate and the House of Representatives deem it necessary
and desirable to amend Joint Rule 4 of the Joint Rules of the Senate and the
House of Representatives.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the Second Regular Ses-
sion of the Sixty-fourth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Rep-
resentatives concurring therein, that the Joint Rule 4 of the Senate and the
House of Representatives shall be amended to read as follows:

JOINT RULE 4

Enrolling and Engrossing. -- After a bill ~~has~~ shall have passed both
houses, it shall be enrolled by the enrolling clerk of the house from which
it originated not later than 48 hours after the time of passage. All bills,
memorials, and resolutions shall be engrossed only in the house in which they
originated.
