McDonald explained the proposed legislation will update current statute to provide for a misdemeanor charge to willful threats of violence directed at schools, school activity venues, school buses, school staff and/or school students, regardless of the point of origin, and delivered by any means of communication. The proposed legislation further provides for charging of a felony if a person is found in possession of dangerous weapons, defined in the section, in the furtherance of carrying out threat and after having made such a threat. An emergency declaration has been added to the proposed legislation.
