

STATEMENT OF PURPOSE

RS26460

The Idaho Board of Chiropractic Physicians is proposing legislation to remove the Board's obligation to provide a peer review process intended to review the appropriateness, quality, utilization and costs of chiropractic services. The Board has determined that this process is unnecessary and wishes to eliminate this regulation.

FISCAL NOTE

There is no impact to the General Fund or the Idaho Bureau of Occupational Licenses' dedicated fund because the proposed legislation will not alter the number of board meetings held each year or require more services be provided to the Idaho Board of Chiropractic Physicians. It should save the Board approximately \$1,000 annually as it will no longer have to provide peer reviews.
