2 RELATING TO THE DIVISION OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT; AMENDING SECTION 67-5202,
3 IDAHO CODE, TO ESTABLISH THE OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES COORDI-
4 NATOR IN THE DIVISION OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT, TO PROVIDE THAT THE COOR-
5 DINATOR SHALL BE APPOINTED BY AND SERVE AT THE PLEASURE OF THE ADMINIS-
6 TRATOR OF THE DIVISION OF FINANCIAL MANAGEMENT, TO REMOVE OBSOLETE LAN-
7 GUAGE, AND TO MAKE TECHNICAL CORRECTIONS.

8 Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

9 SECTION 1. That Section 67-5202, Idaho Code, be, and the same is hereby
10 amended to read as follows:

11 67-5202. OFFICE OF THE ADMINISTRATIVE RULES COORDINATOR. (1) There is
12 hereby established the office of the administrative rules coordinator in the
13 ~~department division of administration~~ financial management. The coordina-
14 tor shall be a nonclassified employee and shall be appointed by and serve
15 at the pleasure of the ~~director~~ administrator of the ~~department division of~~
16 ~~administration~~ financial management. All other employees of the office of
17 the administrative rules employed on July 1, 1996, shall be classified em-
18 ~~ployees, but upon their termination their positions and any positions va-~~
19 ~~eant upon July 1, 1996,~~ coordinator shall be nonclassified positions, and
20 any persons employed to fill positions in the office of the administrative
21 rules coordinator thereafter shall be exempt from the provisions of chapter
22 53, title 67, Idaho Code.

23 (2) The coordinator shall have the authority to make clerical revisions
24 or to correct manifest typographical or grammatical errors to both proposed
25 and existing rules that do not alter the sense, meaning or effect of such
26 rules.

27 (3) The coordinator shall receive all notices and rules required in
28 this chapter to be published in the bulletin or the administrative code.
29 The coordinator shall prescribe a uniform style, form, and numbering system
30 which shall apply to all rules adopted by all agencies. The coordinator
31 shall review all submitted rules for style, form, and numbering, and may
32 return a rule that is not in proper style, form, or number.
