AN ACT

RELATING TO THE APPROPRIATION TO THE REGULATORY BOARDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020;  
APPROPRIATING MONEYS TO THE REGULATORY BOARDS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2020;  
LIMITING THE NUMBER OF AUTHORIZED FULL-TIME EQUIVALENT POSITIONS; AND  
PROVIDING REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY.

Be It Enacted by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Regulatory Boards the following amounts to be expended according to the designated programs and expense classes from the listed fund for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020:

21 SECTION 3. REAPPROPRIATION AUTHORITY. There is hereby reappropriated  
 22 to the Regulatory Boards for the Bureau of Occupational Licenses any un-  
 23 expended and unencumbered balances appropriated to the Regulatory Boards  
 24 for the Bureau of Occupational Licenses from the State Regulatory Fund for  
 25 the upgrade of its database for fiscal year 2019, in an amount not to exceed  
 26 \$1,021,000, to be used for nonrecurring expenditures related to the upgrade  
 27 of its database for the period July 1, 2019, through June 30, 2020.
