1 A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION  
2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE BU-  
3 REAU OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSES RELATING TO THE STATE BOARD OF CHIROPRACTIC  
4 PHYSICIANS.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive  
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the  
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-  
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the  
11 Bureau of Occupational Licenses relating to the State Board of Chiroprac-  
12 tic Physicians are not consistent with legislative intent and should be re-  
13 jected.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-  
15 sion of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, the House of Representatives and  
16 the Senate concurring therein, that IDAPA 24.03.01, relating to the State  
17 Board of Chiropractic Physicians, adopted as a pending rule under Docket  
18 Number 24-0301-1801, the entire rulemaking docket, be, and the same is  
19 hereby rejected and declared null, void, and of no force and effect.
