SENATE AMENDMENT TO S.B. NO. 1037

AMENDMENT TO SECTION 1

2 On page 1 of the printed bill, in line 11, following "any surveyor" in-  
3 sert: "or his subordinate"; and delete lines 23 through 26, and insert:

4 "(4) The surveyor, or any employee or agent of the land surveyor, may  
5 not enter upon land for the purpose of surveying, performing other survey  
6 work, or establishing a permanent survey monument without first providing  
7 prior notice to the landowner or occupant by first class mail or by personal  
8 notice. If the land is occupied by a person other than the landowner, prior  
9 notice must also be given to the occupant by first class mail or by personal  
10 notice. Notice that is given by first class mail must be mailed as soon as  
11 practicable following the contract or agreement to perform the work and at  
12 least seven (7) days prior to the entry onto the land unless the notice period  
13 is waived in writing by the landowner, occupant, or an agent thereof. Notice  
14 that is given by personal notice must be hand-delivered to the landowner or  
15 occupant or, if hand delivery cannot be accomplished, it may be posted in a  
16 conspicuous place where the landowner or occupant may reasonably be expected  
17 to see the notice. The notice shall give the professional land surveyor's  
18 name, address, telephone number, purpose, availability of the survey, and  
19 the presence of any temporary or permanent monuments or other markers to be  
20 established by the surveyor and left on the land. The surveyor or his agent  
21 or employee shall cooperate with the landowner, occupant, or agent thereof  
22 to avoid disruption of a business or agricultural operation."
