A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE  
3 DEPARTMENT OF ADMINISTRATION RELATING TO RULES OF THE DIVISION OF PUR-  
4 CHASING.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive  
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the  
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-  
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the  
11 Department of Administration relating to Rules of the Division of Purchasing  
12 are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-  
14 sion of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-  
15 sentatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 38.05.01, Rules of the Division of  
16 Purchasing, Section 114., Subsection 02.b., adopted as a pending rule under  
17 Docket Number 38-0501-1801, only, be, and the same is hereby rejected and de-  
18 clared null, void, and of no force and effect.
