A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE IN-
3 DUSTRIAL COMMISSION RELATING TO ADMINISTRATIVE RULES OF THE INDUSTRIAL
4 COMMISSION UNDER THE WORKERS' COMPENSATION LAW, SECURITY FOR COMPENSA-
5 TION, AND INSURANCE CARRIERS.

6 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

7 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
8 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
9 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
10 islative intent; and

11 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
12 Industrial Commission relating to Administrative Rules of the Industrial
13 Commission Under the Workers' Compensation Law, Security for Compensation,
14 and Insurance Carriers are not consistent with legislative intent and should
15 be rejected.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
17 sion of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-
18 sentatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 17.02.10, Administrative Rules of
19 the Industrial Commission Under the Workers' Compensation Law, Security for
20 Compensation, and Insurance Carriers, Section 051., Subsection 08.e.ii.,
21 adopted as a pending rule under Docket Number 17-0210-1802, only, be, and the
22 same is hereby rejected and declared null, void, and of no force and effect.
