2 STATING FINDINGS OF THE LEGISLATURE AND REJECTING A CERTAIN RULE OF THE DIVI-
3 SION OF BUILDING SAFETY RELATING TO RULES CONCERNING IDAHO STATE PLUMB-
4 ING CODE.

5 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:

6 WHEREAS, the Legislature is vested with authority to reject executive
7 agency rules under the provisions of Section 67-5291, Idaho Code, in the
8 event that the Legislature finds that the rules are not consistent with leg-
9 islative intent; and

10 WHEREAS, it is the finding of the Legislature that certain rules of the
11 Division of Building Safety relating to Rules Concerning Idaho State Plumb-
12 ing Code are not consistent with legislative intent and should be rejected.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the members of the First Regular Ses-
14 sion of the Sixty-fifth Idaho Legislature, the Senate and the House of Repre-
15 sentatives concurring therein, that IDAPA 07.02.06, Rules Concerning Idaho
16 State Plumbing Code, Section 011., Subsection 35., adopted as a pending rule
17 under Docket Number 07-0206-1702, only, be, and the same is hereby rejected
18 and declared null, void, and of no force and effect.
