A JOINT RESOLUTION

PROPOSING AN AMENDMENT TO SECTION 9, ARTICLE IV, OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE STATE OF IDAHO, RELATING TO EXTRA SESSIONS OF THE LEGISLATURE; STATING THE QUESTION TO BE SUBMITTED TO THE ELECTORATE; DIRECTING THE LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL TO PREPARE THE STATEMENTS REQUIRED BY LAW; AND DIRECTING THE SECRETARY OF STATE TO PUBLISH THE AMENDMENT AND ARGUMENTS AS REQUIRED BY LAW.

- 8 Be It Resolved by the Legislature of the State of Idaho:
- 9 SECTION 1. That Section 9, Article IV, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho be amended to read as follows:
 - Section 9. EXTRA SESSIONS OF LEGISLATURE. The governor may shall, on extraordinary occasions, convene the legislature by proclamation, stating the purposes for which he has convened it; but when so convened it shall have no power to legislate on any subjects other than those specified in the proclamation; but may provide for the expenses of the session and other matters incidental thereto. He may also, by proclamation, convene the senate in extraordinary session for the transaction of executive business.
 - SECTION 2. The question to be submitted to the electors of the State of Idaho at the next general election shall be as follows:
 - "Shall Section 9, Article IV, of the Constitution of the State of Idaho be amended to provide that the Governor shall, on extraordinary occasions, convene the Legislature by proclamation?".
- SECTION 3. The Legislative Council is directed to prepare the statements required by Section 67-453, Idaho Code, and file the same.
- SECTION 4. The Secretary of State is hereby directed to publish this proposed constitutional amendment and arguments as required by law.
